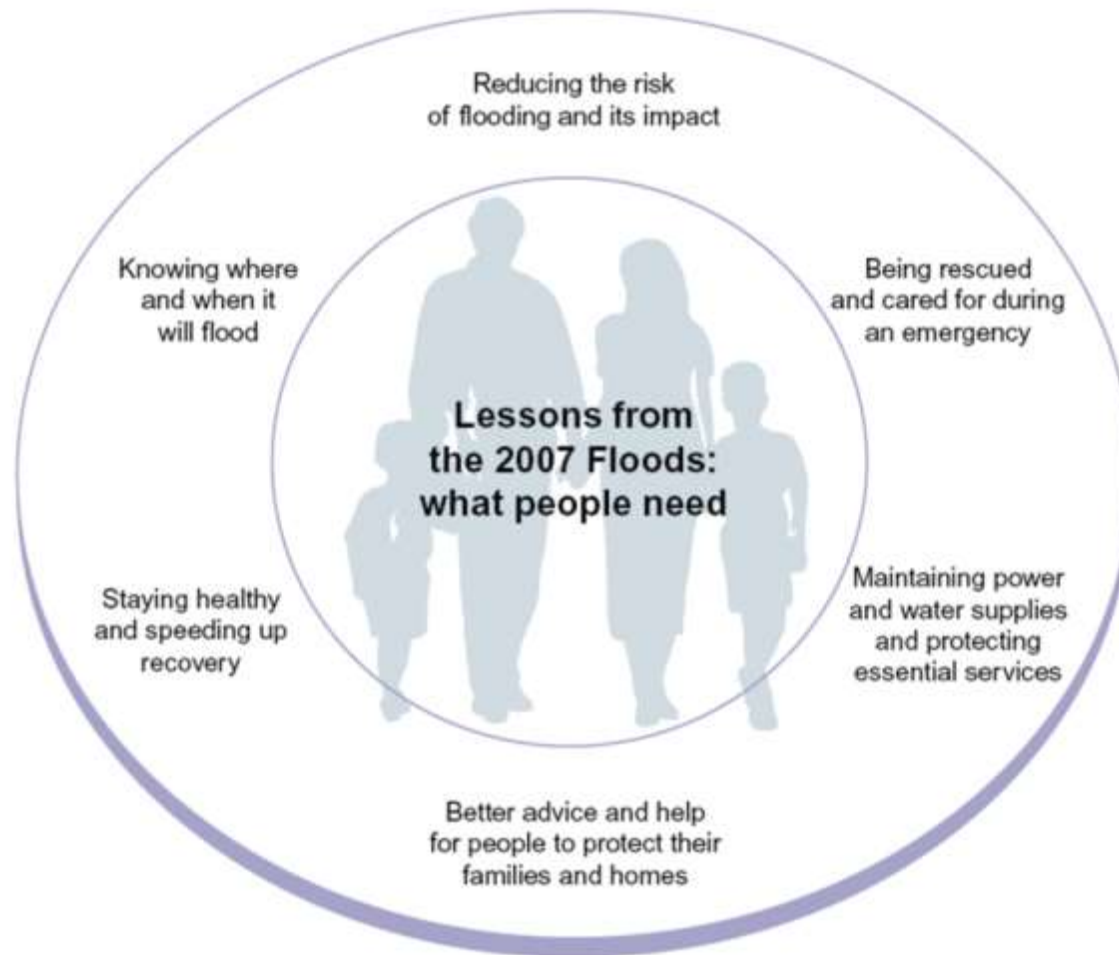

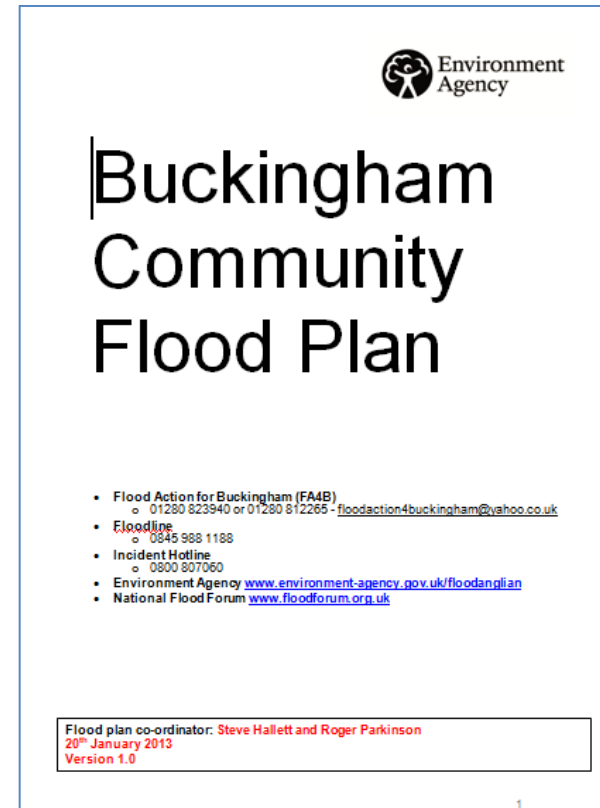
Buckingham Flood Plan
